# CIOMPAC Official Destruction Derby Rules - CARS

1. The original gas tank must be removed, and a max 5-gallon fuel cell in back seat area.
2. All glass, trim, plastic, etc. must be removed
3. All doors and trunk must be welded closed.
4. All cars will be equipped with a bar running behind the drivers seat and attaching to the door post with no larger than a 6"X 6" metal plate
5. Driver protection may not extend beyond 6" behind the driver's seat and must stop at the firewall. If a cage is desired it cannot protrude further than 6 inches to the right of the drivers seat. No reinforcement of the passenger door will be permitted.
6. No Chrysler Imperials.
7. Bumper height is limited to a maximum of 18 inches. (measured to the bottom)
8. Drivers may block the rear end, however, the block can only be secured at on point, either the frame or the rear end, but not both.
9. All drivers must wear eye protection, seat belt and helmet.
10. All cars must have their hoods chained and also have bars in the windshield. Screens are recommended.
11. No reinforcement of chassis or body or bumper of car except for driver protection.
12. Bumpers may be welded to factory brackets, however, no additional reinforcement will be allowed.
13. Maximum of 2 people per pit crew, **no children**, must be 18 or older. Pit passes will be issued to car sponsor.
14. Radiator must remain in original factory position.
15. Must be equipped with a fire extinguisher.
16. OK to use sand bags to weight rear end.
17. All cars must have a 5 inch inspection hole cut into the trunk.
18. These rules must be read and signed by driver/sponsor and returned to CIOMA Office prior to participating in the derby.
19. **No children in the pits at anytime, must be 18 or older.** Viewing of cars will be allowed prior to commencement of Derby.
20. **Drivers must sign and return included Release Agreement before entry in Derby will be allowed.**
21. All fees must be paid in advance – no entry unless paid up.
22. Firebaugh Destruction Derby Safety and Risk Management Committee will inspect all vehicles prior to entry and it retains the sole right to disqualify any car for non-compliance.
23. Claimer Option: Any of the participants would be able to buy any car at the end of the event for an entry fee (\$900). If there is more than one person interested in exercising this option, numbers will be drawn. The exclusion is the POC car.

# CIOMPAC Official Destruction Derby Rules - TRUCKS

1. The original gas tank must be removed, and a max 5-gallon fuel cell in back of truck. Place gas tank in front of the bed closest to the cab if the truck is a standard bed, or behind the seat if the truck is an extra cab or four door.
2. All glass, trim, plastic, etc. must be removed.
3. All doors and tailgate must be welded closed. Tailgate cannot be removed.
4. All trucks will be equipped with a bar running behind the drivers seat and attaching to the door post with no larger than a 6"X 6" metal plate
5. Driver protection may not extend beyond 6" behind the driver's seat and must stop at the firewall. If a cage is desired it cannot protrude further than 6 inches to the right of the drivers seat. No reinforcement of the passenger door will be permitted.
6. No trucks larger than ½ ton. If the truck is 4 wheel drive, only allowed to run single drive line.
7. All rear bumpers and trailer hitches must be completely removed.
8. All drivers must wear eye protection, seat belt and helmet. If the truck does not have a headrest for the driver, one must be installed or suitable replacement installed.
9. All trucks must have their hoods chained and also have bars in the windshield. Screens are recommended.
10. No reinforcement of chassis or body or suspension of truck except for driver protection.
11. Suspension must be stock with no modifications, no raising of suspension.
12. Maximum of 2 people per pit crew, **no children**, must be 18 or older. Pit passes will be issued to car sponsor.
13. Radiator must remain in original factory position.
14. Must be equipped with a fire extinguisher.
15. OK to use sand bags to weight rear end.
16. These rules must be read and signed by driver/sponsor and returned to CIOMA Office prior to participating in the derby.
17. **No children in the pits at anytime, must be 18 or older.** Viewing of cars will be allowed prior to commencement of Derby.
18. **Drivers must sign and return included Release Agreement before entry in Derby will be allowed.**
19. All fees must be paid in advance – no entry unless paid up.
20. Firebaugh Destruction Derby Safety and Risk Management Committee will inspect all vehicles prior to entry and it retains the sole right to disqualify any car for non-compliance. The Firebaugh Safety Committee may elect to make certain changes to all vehicles in order to improve the show for our fans.
21. All trucks will have the frames cut as determined on-site by the Derby Officials.

# Release Agreement

1. I am over the age of eighteen (18) years and am of sound mind and body.
2. I will be participating in the "Eleventh Annual CIOMPAC Destruction Derby" (Destruction Derby) on Saturday, May 1, 2010 as a vehicle driver.

I have been made aware that there are risks associated with participating in the Destruction Derby including but not by way of limitation, the fact that I might get dirty, get bumped and bruised, injured or worse from making contact with other vehicles participating in the Destruction Derby or with fixed objects like fencing, the ground and the like.
4. I will refrain from the consumption of intoxicants on the day of the Destruction Derby until my participation in the Destruction Derby has been completed.
5. The Destruction Derby is an inherently dangerous activity involving the purposeful collision of manned vehicles. I hereby assume all risks associated with my participation and agree to hold the California Independent Oil Marketers Association (CIOMA), the California Independent Oil Marketers Political Action Committee (CIOMPAC), the Firebaugh Destruction Derby Safety and Risk Management Committee and all others associated with this event harmless from any injury, loss or damage of whatever nature suffered by me as a result of my participation in the Destruction Derby or any related events
6. I agree to defend and indemnify the California Independent Oil Marketers Association (CIOMA), the California Independent Oil Marketers Political Action Committee (CIOMPAC), the Firebaugh Destruction Derby Safety and Risk Management Committee and all others associated with this event from any and all claims or threats of claims by any third parties that might result from my participation in the Destruction Derby.
7. I have been advised to obtain legal counsel to represent me as to the contents and legal effect of this release Agreement and I hereby acknowledge and represent that I have either obtained the advice and consent of legal counsel or have specifically elected not to do so.

I hereby certify that I have not been consuming any intoxicant prior to the signing of the release agreement.

I understand that this release agreement inures to the benefits of the assigns, heirs, and successors of any person described herein whether specifically named herein or not.
